#### Communication and Language

- Listen and ask questions to our grown ups and friends.

#### **Literacy**

We are learning to:

- Hear, say and write all the sounds you can hear.
   Challenge can you write cvc words? Eg cat.
- Write about superhero powers, our special toys and read our writing back to a grown up.
- Write sentences using key words. <u>Challenge</u> can you read and write 6 tricky words?
- Blend to read the sounds in simple 3 letter words e.g. mat, tin.

# Expect Success

#### **Mathematical development**

We are learning to:

- Read, write and put in order numbers to 10 and then to 20.
- Understand and begin to use comparative vocabulary such as heavy, lighter, more or less.
- Add one more to a group and say how many altogether.
- Recognise 2D shapes and describe their properties.
- Solve a problem using our maths skills.

#### **Religious Education**

We are learning to:

- Talk about birthdays and celebrations
- Talk about why Christians celebrate Christmas.

#### Physical development

We are learning to:

- Persevere when developing a new skill.
- Develop our fine motor control ensuring a tripod grip when using pencils.
- Write recognisable letters.
- The 'superman' dance and to remember the sequence of movements.

#### **Expressive Arts and Design**

We are learning to:

- Role play imaginary superhero scenarios.
- Explore how sounds can be changed.
- Play cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative.
- Use appropriate materials to make a superhero vehicle.

#### Understanding the World.

We are learning to:

- Show curiosity and make observations when exploring a variety of objects.
- Show care and concern toward animals and living things.
- Program simple instructions on technological toys.
- Understand and talk about similarities and differences.
- Find out about occupations such as 'real life' superheroes. We will also visit the church and post our letters to father Christmas.

## How to support your child's learning at home.

- Reading a bedtime story.
- Try to read a colour banded book daily.
- Help your child write their name, using a capital letter and lower case letters.
- Support your child to dress independently.
- Play number games and sing number rhymes.
- Support your child to recognise numbers and find them in the environment. Can your child write their numbers?
- Help your child to learn letter names and sounds for each letter of the alphabet.
- Practise reading tricky words at home.
- Count everyday objects with your child, practise adding one more and saying how many altogether.
- Look for shapes in the environment, talk to your child about the properties of the shapes. How many corners does it have? How many sides does this shape have?
