We are keeping the drop-off and pick-up arrangements the same as in the autumn term:

Drop-off: 8.45 – 9.00am Pick-up: 2.50-3.05pm.

Nursery AM drop-off : 8.45 – 9.00am Pick-up 11.35-11.45am

Nursery PM drop-off: 12.20 – 12.30pm Pick-up 3.10 – 3.20pm.

Nursery and Year 1 pupils: Please use the top gate entrance by the Nursery building.

Year R and Year 2 pupils: Please use the lower pedestrian entrance in Fairisle Road.

To keep everyone safe please ensure:

- To wear a face covering when present on the school site.
- <u>To arrive within the designated times and do not arrive early to avoid unnecessary</u> <u>congestion outside the classrooms.</u>
- To adhere to social distancing when on the school site, i.e. stand 2 metres apart
- To follow the one-way system for all pedestrian traffic.
- That only one adult per family attends at drop-off and pick-up times.
