	<p>Hook and content:</p> <p>Children will be transferring to new year groups and Year 1 will be e-mailing Year 2 with questions and concerns about being in year 2.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Step 1</u></p> <p>Watch video clip: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gPse7dcXwrU (5mins)</p> <p>Discuss the importance of not giving out any personal information and refer to 'Lock it' slogan and what it means.</p>	<p>Cross-curricular links:</p> <p>S&L links:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use relevant strategies to build their vocabulary. • Articulate, justify answers arguments and opinions. • Participate in discussions. <p>SMSC: ESafety: Revise lock it, block it show it, tell it at the beginning of each session.</p>

<p>Success Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - can tell you why I use technology in the classroom - I can tell you why I use technology in my home and community - I am starting to understand that other people have created the information, creating and communicating - I can talk about the differences between the internet and things in the physical world. - I can understand how to use technology safely - I understand why I need to keep my personal information private 	<p>Discuss e-mail and what it is used for. Share the class the class e-mail address and explain that they must keep it private. Show children how to log on to g-mail, how to check e-mail and how to compose e-mail.</p> <p>Explain that as you are moving to year 2 soon, we could find out what year 2 is like by asking them what it is like/ what they do. Discuss the need to be good 'digital' citizens, just like they are good citizens in our school (polite, not rude etc).</p> <p>As a class compose and e-mail to on eof the year 2 classes asking if they can find out what year 2 is like.</p> <p><u>Step 2 and beyond</u></p> <p>Children to check e-mails and respond in pairs / small groups and reply to e-mails (link to PHSE)</p> <p>Ensure you refer to lock it and being good digital citizens.</p>	
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
