	<p>Hook and content:</p> <p>Children are reading and learning about 'Emily's legs' by Dick King-Smith</p> <hr/> <p>Step 1</p> <p>Log on to Purple Mash (go over how to use log on cards reinforcing 'lock it' and keeping passwords secret). Show children where to find 2 create a story. Look at tools and model selecting different tools, using shapes to draw, adding movement to the picture and sound effects. Children to plan: setting, problem and resolution then give it a title that can also be used as story words in the story.</p> <p>Step 3+</p> <p>In pairs, children write, illustrate and animate their story.
