	Hook and content: Children will be transferring to new year groups and Year 1 will be e-mailing Year 2 with questions and concerns about being in year 2.  Jccess Criteria: I can tell you why I use technology in the classroom I can tell you why I use technology in my home and community I am starting to understand that other people have created the information, creating and communicating I can talk about the differences between the internet and things in the physical world. I can understand how to use technology safely I understand why I need to keep my personal information private I know and understand the lock it, block it, show it tell it rules 	Discuss the importance of not giving out any personal information and refer to 'Lock it' slogan and what it means. Discuss e-mail and what it is used for. Share the class the class e-mail address and explain that they must keep it private. Show children how to log on to g-mail, how to check e-mail and how to compose e-mail. There should be an e-mail from a year 1 class that they can read and discuss how they will responds/ what they will say. Discuss the need to be good 'digital' citizens, just like they are good citizens in our school (polite, not rude etc). In pairs/small groups, compose an e-mail to replay to the year 1 class. <u>Step 2 and beyond</u> Children to check e-mails and respond in pairs / small groups and reply to e-mails (link to PHSE and discuss the need to be positive to stop the year 1 children from worrying). Ensure you refer to lock it and being good digital citizens.	
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
