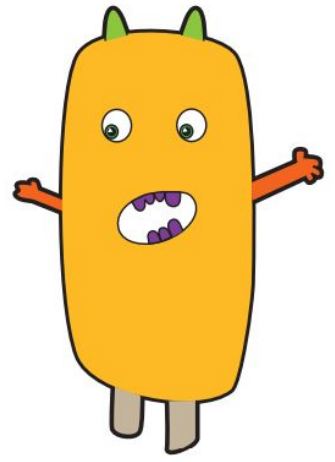
Guidance

This document will help your child practise for the statutory phonics screening test.

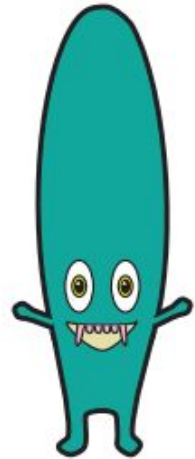
It contains a mixture of real words and pseudo-words (nonsense words), just like the real test they will take in school.
