For the 2025/2026 academic year, Fairisle Infant and Nursery School received £17,780 to help us build capacity and capability in sport within the school, ensuring that improvements to the quality of physical activity provision are sustainable and developing the activities provided.



We have done this by:

- Continuing to strengthen the quality of PE teaching through the use of the Real PE programme, ensuring the delivery of an engaging and high-quality PE curriculum.
- Supporting the PE Leader to access ongoing professional development, enabling them to remain up to date with current best practice and strengthen subject leadership, monitoring and assessment.
- Providing continuing professional development (CPD) to develop the knowledge, skills and confidence of newly appointed staff in teaching gymnastics.
- Offering a range of free, inclusive after-school sports clubs delivered by qualified coaches, encouraging greater participation in physical activity and promoting healthy, active lifestyles.
- Increasing opportunities for pupils to participate in local sporting competitions and festivals, helping them to develop their skills, build confidence, experience positive competition, and foster teamwork and resilience.
- Purchasing PE equipment to enhance children's learning, maximise physical activity during playtimes, and ensure all pupils can access effective physical education through the provision of inclusive and adapted resources.
