Important Reminder

Admission to Infant School—Sept. 2022

If your child's birthday falls between 1 Sept. 2017—31 Aug. 2018 you will need to apply for an Infant School place for your child for next Sept. 2022. All applications should be made on-line via the 'Apply for a School Place' link on Southampton City Council's website.



Transfer to Junior School—Sept. 2022

If your child is currently attending in one of our Year 2 classes you will need to apply for a Junior School place for next September 2022.

Please apply on-line as above via the Southampton City Council website.

All Applications Above MUST be received by Southampton City Council By 23.59 on Saturday 15 January 2022.
